Working bee information – COVID-safe As of 13 November 2020

Welcome to our garden working bee.

The health and safety of all gardeners and visitors is our priority.

Please wear suitable clothing and footwear and provide your own face mask, sun protection, gardening gloves, water bottle, snack (if needed)

If you can, please also BYO: hand tools, bucket for your personal use

In addition, please note the following requirements so that we adhere to COVID-19 restrictions:

- Maximum of 10 people allowed at working bee *
- On arrival see the working bee Coordinator (Janet) who will sign you in
- Sign in will include:
 - your name and phone number, which we must keep for 28 days
 - declaration by you that you are not showing any symptoms of COVID-19.
 - an emergency contact for the day.
- No sharing of tools. Bring your own hand tools and bucket for your own use if you can.
If using our equipment - one person per item.
Our tools and buckets will be cleaned at the end of the working bee.
- Maintain at least 1.5 m between yourself and other workers at all times. If a task cannot be done safely at this distance it is not to be done.
- Do not enter the church building or garden shed unless absolutely necessary.
The Coordinator will get out and put away any items needed for the working bee.
If you need something ask the Coordinator to get it for you.
- If you need to use the toilet or to wash hands use only the accessible/disabled toilet
You will also need to be signed in to the building entry register.
- We are unable to provide refreshments but you are welcome to bring your own snack

*maximum number may change, subject to Government Covid-19 rules
