

# Simply Living Community Garden Seed Exchange

## How it works:

- Share your saved or excess seeds (or bulbs or tubers)
- Take some seeds to grow something yourself
- Save some seeds and bring back to share

## To share your seeds:

1. Put a small number of seeds in a small packet or envelope  
or leave leftover purchased seeds in their original packet
2. Label with name of plant and year collected (for saved seed) or sow by date (for leftover purchased seed)
3. Add any other useful information, such as best time to sow or what the plant is used for (especially if an uncommon plant!)
4. File seeds in the exchange alphabetically by their plant name - eg purple king bean under B for bean  
cos lettuce under L for lettuce

## Tips

- **Make sure your seeds are dry** when you package them and packets are dry when placed in seed exchange - we don't want everything to go mouldy and be wasted!
- Check the best sowing time before you plant seeds
- Shut the drawers to keep seeds safe and dry
